MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING (MoU) between

This MoU may be revised through the mutual agreement of both institutions and may be terminated by either institutions upon giving six months' written notice signed by the president and, or secretary / Principal of the notifying institution.

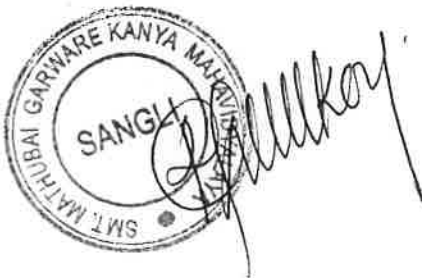
Term

The term is for 10 years, from the date of signing of this agreement. The agreement shall be automatically renewable after expiry of the initial term for a term equal to the initial term.

Financial Terms

RJIL shall pay to S.M.G.Kanya Mahavidyalaya, Sangli a fee of Rs. 0/- (Rupees _____ Only.) per month per equipment. The fee shall be paid monthly in advance subject to an escalation of _____% on the last paid Fee amount after every 1 years. The payment of Fee shall commence from _____. The monthly Fee to be paid by RJIL shall be made only by a separate Cheque / DD/ ECS/ RTGS in the favour of _____.

The fee shall be inclusive of all maintenance charges levied by S.M.G.Kanya Mahavidyalaya, Sangli or any other tax or cess levied by government. Further the fee shall be payable subject to deduction of tax at source as per the provisions of the Income Tax Act. Service tax, if applicable, shall be additionally payable by RJIL upon receipt of service tax compliant invoice from S.M.G.Kanya Mahavidyalaya, Sangli.

RJIL shall be responsible for all legal and regulatory obligations required for its services and shall indemnify S.M.G.Kanya Mahavidyalaya, Sangli from any legal and regulatory obligations in relation to its License.

Termination

RJIL shall have the right to terminate this Agreement, by giving 60 (sixty) days' notice in writing to S.M.G.Kanya Mahavidyalaya, Sangli. Upon the expiry of 60 (sixty) days from the date of notice, as aforesaid, the Agreement shall stand terminated. S.M.G.Kanya Mahavidyalaya, Sangli shall not have any right to terminate the agreement except for instances wherein RJIL has committed a material breach of terms provided herein and the same is not rectified by RJIL within 30 (thirty) days of intimation of such breach in writing by the S.M.G.Kanya Mahavidyalaya, Sangli. In case the breach is committed by RJIL and is not rectified, S.M.G.Kanya Mahavidyalaya, Sangli shall be entitled to terminate the Agreement by giving 90 (Ninety) days' notice. On termination, all Marketing Material and Network installations provided by RJIL shall be removed by RJIL.

Governing Law & Jurisdiction

The provisions of this Agreement and the rights and obligations of the Parties under or arising out of this Agreement shall be governed by, construed and enforced in accordance with the laws of India and the Courts of Sangli shall have exclusive jurisdiction over the matters relating to or arising from this Agreement.

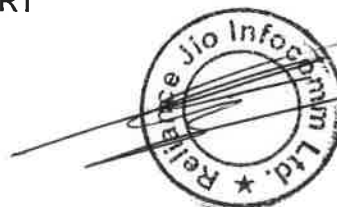

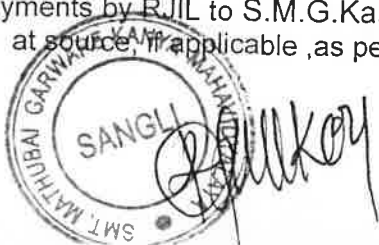

RJIL Responsibilities

1. Install and Commission Telecom equipment consisting of equipment and Cable i.e. Feeder and/or Optical Fiber Cable (OFC) etc. for providing telecommunication services in all Sites as mentioned in Appendix A and additional sites added in future as per the feasibility of RJIL.
2. Optimum deployment of Access Points/Small Cells and Installation of telecom equipment would be decided by RJIL installation team.
3. Keeping the network operational and assisting in resolving network / equipment related issues (such as network faults, systemic issues and outages)
4. Operate and provide services through the Central Customer Care Center (end user), to address customer (end user) queries and concerns.
5. Provide publicity to S.M.G.Kanya Mahavidyalaya, Sangli by listing their Sites as available hotspots sites in RJIL's website or through any other means which RJIL deems fit.
6. RJIL reserves rights of Digital Marketing & Communication and for all changes in rate/ Tariff conditions and updates on Wi-Fi Hot spots. Digital spaces would always remain the property of RJIL, which includes platform like Landing Page, Login flow pages, RJIL website etc.
7. Pricing and tariff planning of telecommunication service will be sole prerogative of RJIL.
8. RJIL will abide by DoT guidelines with respect to Maintaining customer (end user) usage records, Ensuring on-line security & privacy of users and Blocking of web contents
9. RJIL will have the full rights to obtain and use the consumers' data, and use it as RJIL deems appropriate within Indian legal framework.
10. RJIL may modify, restrict, suspend or temporarily cease access to its Telecommunication Services at any time in order to test the operation of its network or to carry out maintenance, technical repair, enhancement or emergency work.
11. RJIL shall be exclusive provider of its telecommunication services and Pico cell/ Femto cell/ Wi-Fi/ Small cells at "S.M.G.Kanya Mahavidyalaya, Sangli" Sites.

Preamble

And acknowledging that the benefits to all the stakeholders of the programme include such **benefits to the students** as developing core employability skills (including attitudinal and affective skills such as team work, decision making, learning, and values and attitudes such as integrity, self-discipline willingness to learn, flexibility, goal oriented), enhancing communication skills (such as team discussion, presentation, consultation, and clear thinking), becoming joyful learners with moral capabilities, leadership abilities and enhanced self-confidence, forming a global perspective and world-view, developing their vision and purpose in life, and serving communities. And in short they become "Leaders", but leaders of a new kind. And **benefits to the teachers** include boosting their professional growth through grooming their capabilities to meet the growing challenges of their professional and social mission, redefining their relationship with students and improving their interactive teaching skills and cooperative/experiential learning competence, overhauling their personalities and working out fresh value-based attitudes towards their institution and co-workers. And **benefits to the College** include training teachers in cooperative and participatory learning and becoming mentors for the modules of education in universal human values, implementing such meaningful Service Learning Activities by the students in the college neighborhood and target communities, promoting quality education by meeting the criteria set by NAAC (NBA, TEQIP), promoting unity of vision and thought among students and staff, changing their attitudes towards their responsibilities, enhancing leadership capabilities to fulfil the institution's vision and mission, and implementing innovative extension activities.

And further noting the Courses/Activities being offered by the Academy under this MoU is called

A) "Fostering Personal Development & Social Progress", for U.G. students, that is offered at four levels as follows:

2. Smt. Mathubai Garware Kanya Mahavidyalaya's Commitment:

- i- The College decides and informs the Bahá'í Academy what percentage of its students and teachers should receive the benefits for this MoU during its 5-year term.
- ii- The College will provide financial support for Teachers' Orientation Workshops/FDPs.
- iii- The College will ensure that on completion of their training the trained teachers (who will become mentors for Education in Universal Human Values programme) form Study Groups of about 25 students each and implement the Course among them on payment of the Course fees by the students. Students can grow through higher modules each subsequent year and achieve higher levels of competence and certification.
- iv- The College will ensure that adequate publicity is given to the programme among the students through various means.
- v- The College will provide a slot of 3-4 hours in its weekly timetable (for about 10 weeks in one or two semesters) and/or a few days camp in its annual calendar for implementing contact sessions and service learning activities, that is a total of 40 hours per module for contact sessions and about for 30 hours for Service Learning Activities/Community Project.
- vi- The College will ensure that the mentors' reports and students' assignments are submitted to the Academy on time for evaluation.

The College nominates (a capable and interested staff member) to be the Programme Coordinator at the College and be the liaison with the Academy.

3. Shared Responsibilities:

- i. Both parties to this Memorandum undertake to promote its terms and implement the same in good faith and in a spirit of mutual co-operation.
- ii. Either or both the parties may propose changes to the implementation strategies as the programme progresses, bearing in mind the feedback from trainers and the course participants. If these changes are accepted by both parties as adding value to the courses, both organizations continue to present the courses as joint awards.
- iii. Subject to any financial constraints and any such arrangements as may be necessary to safeguard the confidentiality of any information or documents, the parties agree to provide each other with such documents, information or materials as may be necessary for any activity to be carried out under this memorandum.
- iv. Quality control is the shared responsibility of both the parties, each one in its own sphere of activities and roles.
- v. Both the parties share the right of accepting into the course students who desire to join the course.
- vi. Although evaluation and assessment is carried out by the Bahá'í Academy, certificates and transcripts are issued jointly by the College and the Academy.

4. Financial Implications:

A. Teachers Workshop (FDP) at the Academy: Rs. 6000/- per participant for 5 days. This includes study kit, training, breakfast, lunch, dinner, tea and refreshment twice in a day, evaluation and certification. If the FDP is held at the College, the fees will be Rs. 2150/- per person for 5 days, plus travelling expenses and hospitality for the Academy's Resource Persons.

B. Students Campaign at the College: Rs 1510/- per student for 5-day Campaign at the College. The Campaign will be conducted by the Resource Persons from the Academy.

C. Refresher Course for non-teaching staff members: Rs. 515/- for the initial one day Workshop at the College. This includes study kit and training. Hospitality and travelling expenses will be provided to the Resource Persons as per the University norms. This Workshop will be followed by a two-day workshop at the Academy @Rs. 2120/- per participant for two days. This includes training, breakfast, lunch, dinner, tea and refreshment twice in a day, and certificate. Multimedia hall will be provided free of charge.

The above mentioned fees will be reviewed after two years to offset the inflation, etc.



Introduction:

An expressed goal of the Department of Adult and Continuing Education and Extension Work of Shivaji University is establishing a network to carry out activities on propagation of Education in Universal Human Values. To achieve this goal in an ongoing and regular basis it is proposed that the necessary capacity should be created in the Lead Colleges under the University and gradually expand it to other colleges too in a phased manner. It is a collaborative venture to carry out activities on training teachers and students on Education in Universal Human Values.

Therefore as part of an ongoing activity the Department of Adult and Continuing Education and Extension Work of Shivaji University, Kolhapur, and the Baha'i Academy, Panchgani have, in collaboration, so far conducted eight introductory workshops on "Propagation of Education in Universal Human Values" in the eight Lead Colleges of Shivaji University from Feb. to Oct. 2015.

Objectives of the Introductory Workshops:

1. To introduce Education in Universal Human Values to selected groups of teachers and students at Lead Colleges
2. To motivate them to develop leadership skills through implementing meaningful service activities
3. To encourage them to arrange seminars on Education in Universal Human Values in other colleges under Lead College Scheme

One day workshop on Universal Human value
Under the Lead College Scheme of the Shivaji University, Kolhapur
In Smt. Mathubai Garware Women College, Sangli
10th of February 2015

A One day introductory workshop was held in Smt. Mathubai Garware Women College, Sangli. The programme started with an inaugural function with felicitation of the invitees – Mr. Lesan Azadi (Director Bahá'í Academy), Dr. Goraknath Kamble (Director of Adult and Continuing Education and Extension Work– Shivaji University), Dr. Shashi Gaikwad (Asst. Director, Baha'i Academy), by the Principal of the College Dr R. G. Kulkarni who presented a book to each of the guests. A memento of the Baha'i Academy was presented to the Principle Dr. Kulkarni by the Director of the Baha'i Academy. About 50 students from 8 cluster colleges participated in this one day workshop on Universal Human Value education under the title "Education for Change". Eight teachers also participated in the programme. The session started around 11.30 a.m and continued up to 4.30 p.m.. Certificates were given to all the students who participated in the workshop.

Principle of the Lead College Dr. R. G. Kulkarni in his speech stressed the importance of such value based approach to education and urged the students to take full advantage of this programme. He mentioned that such education was the need of the hour. He also spoke about two aspects of education – worldly and spiritual. Education should be knowledge oriented and not exam oriented. He concluded his speech by quoting words of Abraham Lincoln which stresses the importance of values in life.

Dr. Kamble spoke about the need for Universal Human Value Education and assured the students that they will learn about this in today's workshop. He gave examples of how the different setting of relationships in society is deteriorating and losing the relevance of values day by day. Education is becoming more and more based on personal gain and benefits. He also mentioned the importance of the role of teachers in this process. It is clear that human values is very much needed in social environment.

The workshop was conducted by Mr. L. Azadi, and Dr. Shashi Gaikwad. He first welcomed the students from each of the eight colleges and immediately formed ten groups for interactive discussions and study the material related to Universal Human Value education. While forming the groups the students were mixed from all the different colleges.

The students were asked to introduce each other to become friends. They then discussed the question "What do human values mean to you?" while the group coordinators assisted by summarizing and contributing to the discussion. Some of the responses are given below:

- Equality between man and woman
- Human Rights mentioned in the Indian constitution
- Respecting the dignity of every person's human rights
- Bringing all together

Another question "Is it necessary to practice Universal Human Values in today's world? Why or why not?" was posed to them for group consultation. Some of their responses are given below:

- For smooth functioning of human society in the world
- For there has been so much abuse of human values in recent times
- Removing inequality in society.

Having had a lively and active interaction with the students, he proceeded with presenting a PowerPoint on Universal Human Values Education with the topic "Education for Change".

The group was asked to mark their feelings at the start and end of the Workshop on a Feedback paper. Another question was asked to the student with the help of PowerPoint "What change? Some of the responses are given below:

- Need to improve self-confidence
- Change the perspective on politics
- Inspire to see the positive side of things
- Personal and social change such as free from corruption and bad leadership

The students were requested to write down in detail their responses and submit it at the end of the workshop. Another question "Which values do you practice in your group discussion?" was asked to the group. Some of the responses are given below:

- Unity
- Cooperation
- Respect for each other
- Coordination

All these values needed to be given opportunity for expressing themselves, it was commented. We know that each one of us is "like mine full of gems" and the qualities students mentioned are some of the gems. Education in Universal Human values is intended precisely to nurture these values from within every student as they undergo a process of education.

The students were then encouraged to study the first lesson of Moral Capabilities in their respective groups. The group study was conducted by the Director Mr. L. Azadi with the assistance of Dr. Shashi Gaikwad, Mr. Navnath and Mr. Satish. At the end of the Workshop the students of each college sat in one group to make an action plan based on the understanding they had gained and what they intend to do in their colleges.

They submitted their action plan along with their feedback forms, and a note from the students about what kind of 'change' they wanted in their life and the society. Students were given posters along with brochures in English and Marathi to take back to their College principals. Certificates were given to the participating students by the respected guests and the Principal of the College. The students were encouraged to express their feelings about their experience. All the students who came up to speak expressed that this was a most needed aspect of education for the students as well as for the wider society and such gatherings should be held more often.

Students' Feedback

At the end of each Workshop students were asked to answer anonymously the following four questions:

1. What did you like in this workshop?
2. What did you learn from this workshop?
3. What decisions you made in this workshop to carry out when you return from here?
4. Do you want to study other modules of the Academy programme?

Their answers have been analyzed as follows:

1. What did you like in this workshop?

Findings:

It is observed that the highest option for liking is the 'Cooperative Learning methodology' used in the Workshop where 104 responses have been received.

Education in Universal Human Values received 74 responses. The overall presentation of the Workshop scored 58 and the short movie on leadership 55 followed by the Vision Game 29, and Music 19.

Interpretation:

The Cooperative Learning is liked the most because in the workshop all the students had active participation, everyone got an opportunity to think, discuss in groups and speak which usually is not the case in their routine classes at their colleges.

Conclusion:

Cooperative Learning Structure is effective and useful for implementing Education in Universal Human Values.

Findings:

It is observed that what students learnt the most was 'Human Values' where 128 responses have been received. 'Leadership Qualities' received 64 responses, while 58 students responded for the change in society, 41 responded for development of capabilities, and 36 responded for personality development. Following options received less responses - work for building universal culture, social responsibilities, time management, how to behave in society.

Interpretation:

Students are quite receptive to learn about Universal Human Values that are very much needed for development of moral capabilities and bring about change in society. It seems these are being appreciated by the youth.

Conclusion:

Human Value Education and Leadership for bringing about change in society is well received by the students.

Findings:

It is observed that the highest option of response is 55 for organizing literacy programme, 52 would conduct workshop on human value education for youth, 32 for making change in society, 26 for working for social unity, 21 for eradication of blind faith and similar responses for human value education. Carrying out the activities to stop child labor and child marriage, and to help the needy people, and creating a clean society are among other decisions students made.

Interpretation:

Organizing literacy programme is the most desired activity by the students who also want to bring change in society, and eradicate blind faith, bring social unity, promote human right, and remove corruption from the society,

Conclusion:

Students got inspiration from the workshop to carry out various projects in the society.

Findings:

It is observed that to study the modules of Education in Universal Human Values Programme received 300 responses that is the highest option, out of which 126 want to do the modules in their respective colleges, 110 online, and 52 at the Baha'i Academy.

Conclusion:

Students have shown keen interest in studying other modules of Education in Universal Human Values. About 50% of the students are interested to study modules on Education in Universal Human Values for self development and contributing to social progress.

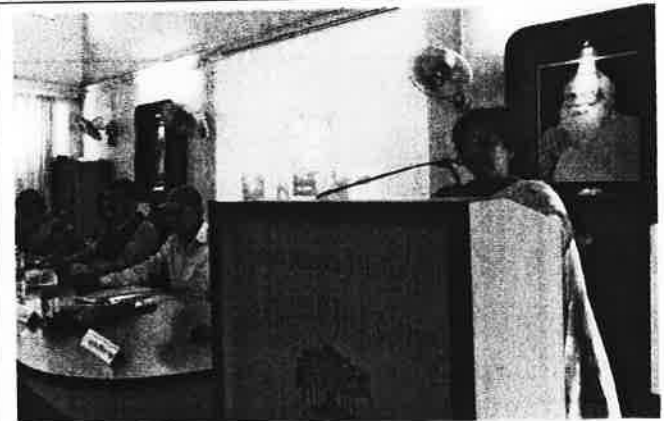

Proposal for establishing a network of 'Students' Development Cells' in Lead Colleges to carryout activities on propagation of Education in Universal Human Values®

An expressed goal of the Department of Adult and Continuing Education and Extension Services of Shivaji University is establishing a network to carry out activities on propagation of Education in Universal Human Values®. To achieve this goal in an ongoing and regular basis it is proposed that the necessary capacity should be created in the Lead Colleges under the University and gradually expands it to other colleges too in a phased manner. The proposal suggests establishing a network of 'Students' Development Cells' in Lead Colleges as a collaborative venture to carry out activities on propagation of Education in Universal Human Values®.

The proposed focus of theses 'Cells' is three-fold:

- Training selected groups of teachers and students at Lead colleges annually to play the role of resource persons for community action and training other college students
- Developing leadership skills among these students through implementing meaningful service activities on promoting rectitude of conduct and unity in diversity in the college and the neighborhood
- Arrange seminars and training programmes on Education in Universal Human Values ®in other colleges under Lead Colleges

The implementation strategy can include

- Selecting a core group of five young and interested teachers from each Lead college to receive a week long TOT orientation on developing moral capabilities (Note: Training may be divided into parts)
- Implementing moral capabilities programme by the trained teachers among 100capable students of each Lead College
- The trained students to carry out a two-fold activity of
 - a. Meaningful service projects in the College neighborhood in collaboration with local stakeholders to enhance their own capabilities and render community services
 - b. Arrange educational programmes such as Seminars, Round Tables, Discourses, Shows and artistic presentations at other colleges on themes related to Education in Universal Human Values®

It is hoped that this collaborative initiative of the Dept. Adult and Continuing Education and Extension Services, the Bahá'í Academy and the Lead Colleges will initiate a positive social

change and continuously develop a new brand of college graduates and young professionals who are more inclined towards practicing universal human values and rendering selfless services to the society.

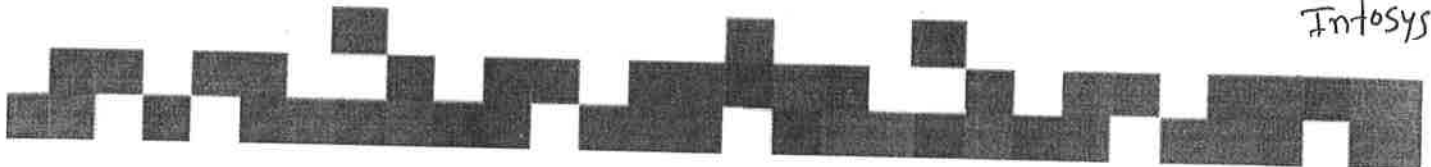

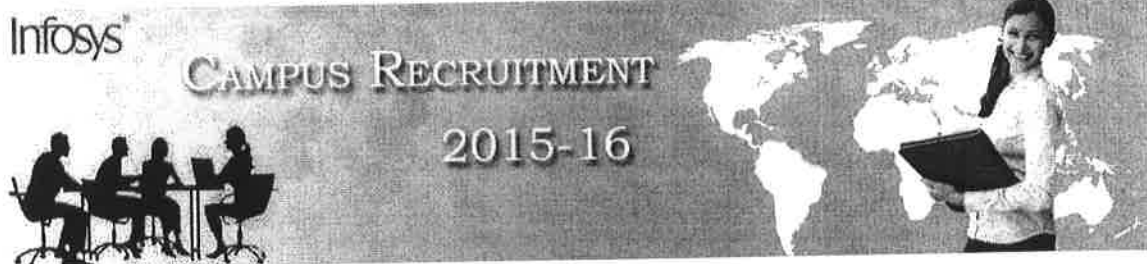
