3. To prepare students for interviews and presentations.

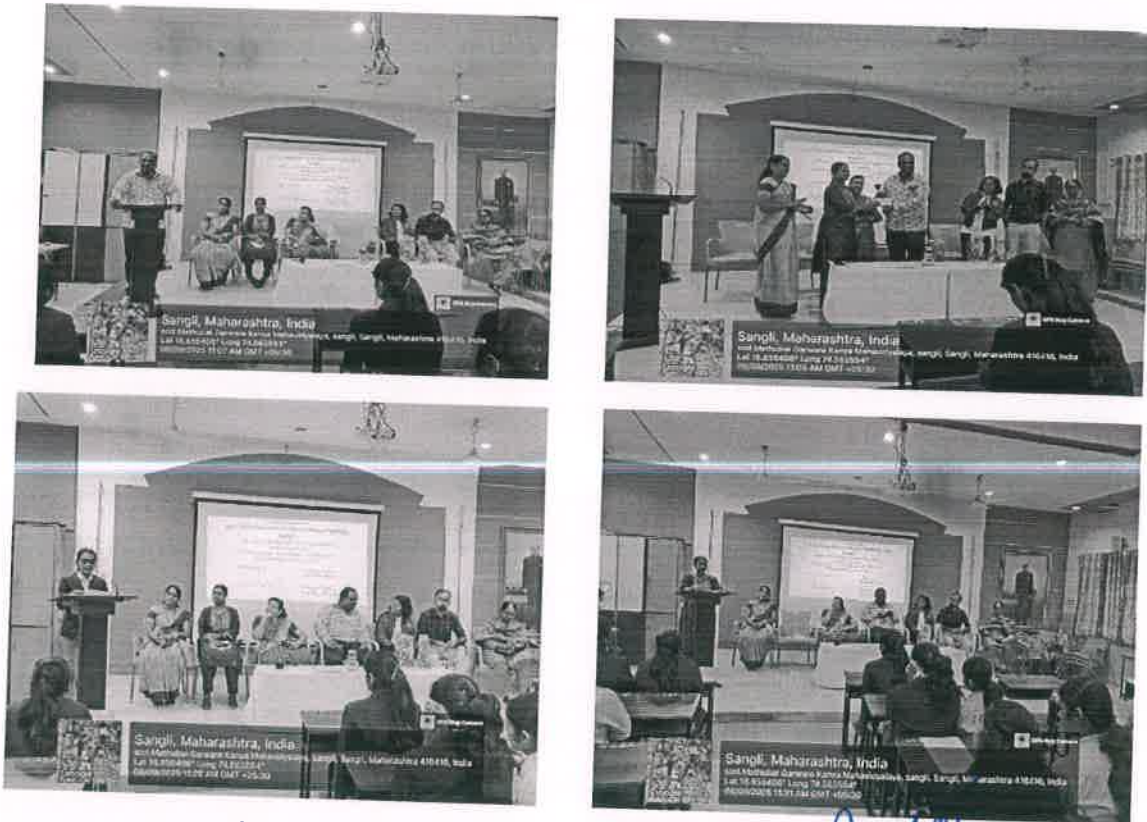
- **Learning outcomes of the Programme/Activity:** -
